

Hello from Camp Lincoln and Camp Lake Hubert!

This is just a note to help clarify enrollment procedures for our Spanish speaking campers and families.

As you know, we do try to maintain a diverse population of campers from all across the USA and are fortunate to have children from many international countries as well. At the same time, many of our international families request that their children not be with other campers who speak their native language, so that English is used as much as possible.

We do try to honor this request as it best fits with our camp goals as well – providing a diverse mix of children within each cabin group. As a result, we do limit the number of Spanish speaking children in each specific age group and for each session, so that we can maintain that diversity goal and provide campers with a good variety of friends.

As our clientele grows from Mexico and other Spanish speaking countries, we also know that space in each age group is limited. Thus, we do have a priority system in place.

1. Campers from Summer 2008 will have priority enrollment up through September, 2008.
2. Even with this priority, know that space is limited in each age group and priority is given by date of enrollment..
3. Starting in October, 2008, new families will be able to enroll, provided space in that age group is available.
4. It is best to enroll on-line, with the proper deposit.
