

# 2023 ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

## APPLICATION DETAILS

- The camps are open to boys and girls of good character who, if accepted, must participate in our camp community fully in a positive, productive manner. We reserve the right to accept or reject camper applications. Our camp mission statement and our core values are our guiding principles. Spiritually, our camps have a Christian Foundation, but we accept and respect the different spiritual beliefs of all persons in our community.
- Filing application implies understanding, by camper and parents, of our policy that there shall be no chewing tobacco, drinking of alcoholic beverages, possession of or use of illicit drugs, smoking, or vaping during the camp session. We reserve the right to dismiss any camper whose actions, attitude, behavior, or words, in our judgment, is contrary to the best interests of camp.
- Enrollment is limited in some session lengths, based on age/grade and spaces available, especially in some of the shorter-term camp sessions. Waitlists are accepted in all camp sessions.
- We practice safety at all times, to the best of our ability; however, participation in activities and in camp life has inherent injuries and risks sometimes do occur. With enrollment, parents acknowledge and accept this fact and agree to hold harmless the camps, its agents, and employees against any and all claims, damages, and injuries.
- A resident medical staff member is available for routine medical services, but the cost of consulting doctors, hospital visits, illness expenses, and/or special medications are not included in the camp fee.
- We cannot be responsible for clothing, electronics, jewelry, watches, or other personal property brought to camp. We will deposit any valuables in our camp safe, if turned over to us, upon arrival. We highly recommend the use of name tape for marking all clothing and gear.

## APPLICATION DETAILS (Continued)

- 2-Weeks 1 and 2:** An opportunity to experience first-hand the benefits of the traditional camp experience. Available for boys who are currently in 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> Grades, and for girls who are currently in 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades.
- 2-Weeks 3 and 4:** An opportunity to experience first-hand the benefits of traditional camp experience. Available for boys who are currently in 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades, and for girls who are currently in 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades.

**4-Weeks 1 and 2:** The classic camp experience. Available for boys who are currently in 2<sup>nd</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> Grades and for girls who are currently in 3<sup>rd</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> Grades.

**Leadership Training (LT) Program:** In 2023, this program is available for boys who are currently in 10<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup> Grades and for girls who are currently in 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Grades. The LT Programs have a separate application process. Please contact your camp's specific director for additional information regarding these programs.

- The application and deposit constitute an enrollment agreement only when accepted by a Camp Lincoln and Camp Lake Hubert Director in writing and shall be construed in and under the laws of the State of Minnesota. Any claim or controversy arising out of or relating to this enrollment agreement or the breach thereof which cannot be resolved in accordance with the terms hereof, shall be filed with and settled by the American Arbitration Association's Minnesota Regional Office in accordance with the then existing Rules of the American Arbitration Association, and any award rendered by the arbitrator or arbitrators may be entered in either the District Court of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, or the United States Court, District of Minnesota. This agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. We consider your enrollment and/or payment as acceptance and acknowledgement of all the terms of this agreement.

It is understood by campers and parents that any pictures, portraits and/or videos of the camper taken at camp, quotes, and/or other written materials may be used by Camp Lincoln and Camp Lake Hubert or their assigned agents for advertising, art, and promotional information. Parents and campers waive the right to approve and/or inspect the finished product or copy. A list of camper names and addresses may be distributed for camper's use.

### Cancellation:

No reduction of tuition is made for late arrival, early departure, or dismissal. Early departure and late arrivals must be approved by the specific camp director prior to the camp season. Cancellation Fees are not reduced for medical reasons.

**Deposit for Miscellaneous Expenditures:** An expense deposit is required in addition to the camp tuition. This deposit payment is required in advance to serve as a drawing account for the camper. The final statement will invoice the estimated deposit for expenditures for the session in camp, i.e.

\$150.00 for 2-Week Sessions    \$250.00 for 4-Week Sessions

Items charged against this account when applicable: camp bedding, camp store items, illness expense, laundry, local and special trips, medical prescriptions, and yearbook.

Only those services actually used, or items purchased will be charged and any balance remaining will be refunded or overdraft will be billed in the fall.

## TRANSPORTATION

We coordinate air travel arrangements through Travel One (1-800-245-1111). All campers are met at their gate upon arrival at the Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport. Chartered Bus Service to and from camp for all airport campers is provided at a nominal charge. Chartered Bus Service to and from camp for local campers is also provided at a nominal charge from a Minneapolis Suburban Location.

**If flying,** please plan arrival at the Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport

**between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm** on Arrival Day and

**departure between 12:00 pm (NOON) and 4:00 pm** on Departure Day.

Requests to arrive or depart outside of these times, or on days other than the scheduled arrival and/or departure day, will need the prior approval of a Camp Director, and may incur an additional charge. Camp Director Approval is also needed if you wish to pick up your camper for an event during the camp session. Please submit requests at your earliest convenience, and at least 30 days prior to the camp session. Failure to gain approval may cause the cancellation of your child's camp registration, subject to our cancellation policy.

**Check-In:    Between 1:00 pm – 4:30 pm on Arrival Day**

**Check-Out:    Between 8:00 am – 10:30 am on Departure Day**
